# A/Prof. Evan Y Yu

M.D., is an Associate Professor of Medicine (Oncology) at the University of Washington School of Medicine and also an Associate Member of the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center. He gradu-

ated with honors from the University of Washington School of Medicine and was elected a member of the Alpha Omega Alpha Honors Society in 1998. He then went on to train in internal medicine at the Brigham and Women's Hospital and then completed oncology fellowship at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and Massachusetts General Hospital. In 2004, he returned to Seattle as a genitourinary medical oncologist, and he has been at the rank of Associate Professor since 2010.

Although Dr. Yu trained in a basic science environment, he now performs clinical/translational research with a focus on new prostate cancer therapeutics. biomarkers and molecular imaging. He is the Assistant Fellowship Director at the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center for the hematology/oncology training program. He also serves at the Clinical Trials Director for genitourinary malignancies in his institution and co-leads the Clinical Core of the Pacific Northwest Prostate Cancer SPORE. He is a member of the National Cancer Institute's Genitourinary Cancers Steering Committee. He has been an active member in multiple cooperative groups, leading clinical trials in SWOG, ACRIN and also the Department of Defense sponsored Prostate Cancer Clinical Trials Consortium. Dr. Yu is regularly selected as a "Top Doctor" by Seattle Magazine, Seattle Met Magazine, U.S. News and World Report and Castle Connolly.

## Prof. William K Oh

M.D., is Chief of the Division of Hematology/Medical Oncology and Associate Director for Clinical Research for the Tisch Cancer Institute at Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai. Dr. Oh's research interests include novel biomarkers

and therapeutics in advanced prostate cancer. He has served as the principal investigator of multiple clinical trials and developed large databases in prostate, renal and bladder cancer patients.

Dr. Oh has authored over 230 original articles, reviews and book chapters. He has served in key roles for the American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) and the American Urological Association (AUA). In addition to reviewing for prominent journals such as the New England Journal of Medicine, Journal of Clinical Oncology, and Cancer, Dr. Oh co-edits "Testicular Cancer" for Up to Date and is Associate Editor of CA, A Cancer Journal for Clinicians. He has been repeatedly selected as a Top Doctor in New York Magazine, Castle Connolly, Best Doctors and Super Doctors.

Dr. Oh received his MD from New York University School of Medicine. He completed his residency in internal medicine at Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston and fellowship in medical oncology at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute in 1997.
