In Memory of Professor Li-Xin Qian

Prof. Li-Xin Qian, professor of the Department of Urology of the First Affiliated Hospital of Nanjing Medical University, passed away on Jan. 11, 2006, in a traffic accident. He was 40 years old, born in October, 1966 in Changzhou, Jiangsu Province, China.

As one of the “135” Medical Important Talents of Jiangsu Province, Prof. Li-Xin Qian was an outstanding young scientific doctor and superior academic leader in urology in the hospital, he presided over more than 10 items of scientific research projects, including those supported by National Natural Science Foundation. He had been assigned 15 technological research finding awards, and had published 83 research papers. In addition to his various responsibilities, such as supervising graduate students, leading research projects and administrating Nanjing Human Sperm Bank, he worked as the deputy in many medical associations and the editorial board member of Asian Journal of Andrology and many other famous medical journals. He had submitted and recommended many valuable research papers to our Asian Journal of Andrology, which was highly praised by scholars in the field of urology and andrology.

Prof. Li-Xin Qian devoted all his life to his loved medical researching and medical teaching. He was a great doctor, colleague, mentor and friend. We will all miss him for his dedication to his career and to our Asian Journal of Andrology.
