Dr. Daniela Erna Andrich MD MSc FRCS

Consultant Reconstructive Urological Surgeon

Daniela Andrich graduated from Ludwig Maximillians University Munich in 1996, after spending her last medical school year as an affiliated student at University College London (UCL) on a DAAD scholarship.

In 1996, she was awarded a 'cum laude' MD degree from the Humboldt University Berlin for basic research on monoclonal T-cell antibodies whilst still a Medical Student at the University Ulm under the supervision of Professor Wolfram Sterry. For her Master of Science degree in Urology from UCL in 2002 she was awarded the Geoffrey Chisholm Prize.

She obtained a Fellowship of the Royal College of Surgeons of England in 2005 and completed her urological specialty training 2007.

Since 2008, she works as a Consultant Reconstructive Urological Surgeon at the Institute of Urology, University College London Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust (UCLH) and London Bridge Hospital (HCA), with a special interest in all aspects of urethral stricture disease, surgical management of male and female urinary incontinence and the repair of iatrogenic injury such as urinary fistulae.

Since 2007, Daniela organises the annual 'Masterclass of Genitourethral Reconstructive Surgery' at the Institute of Urology, UCLH. She is participating regularly in other international live-surgery workshops and is a regular speaker at international urological meetings.

Daniela has been President of the Society of Genitourinary Reconstructive Surgery (GURS) in June 2015.

Her clinical research interests include prevention of iatrogenic lower urinary tract injury and regenerative treatment for urethral strictures.
